BASICS OF CUB SCOUT ADVANCEMENT - Learn the basics of the Cub Scout Advancement program, including tips for proper and accurate record keeping.



WEBELOS LEADER SESSIONS

Join our experienced staff as we bump, set, and spike some of these sessions:



COUNCIL EVENTS - Webelos Summer Camp, Webelos Experience, Fun with Son, Rum River and Stearns Scout Camp availability, procedure and usage will be covered.

WEBELOS TO BOY SCOUT TRANSITION - Learn how to provide a smooth transition to the Boy Scout program. Explore who is involved, how a troop operates, and why Webelos activities including the Arrow of Light help in this adventure. Learn more of what you can do to benefit from other's adventures through training and working with a troop.

ACTIVITY BADGES - These explorers have been to the new world and want to share with you the knowledge they have gained from their travels. They can point you in the right direction and keep you on course to your destination. They will map out different activities that have helped them advance their Webelos. Individual activity badges will be offered.

OUTDOOR SKILLS - This adventure will highlight information on keeping your young Webelos explorers and their parents warm, dry, happy and fed.



COMMITTEE MEMBER

Sessions will include presentations on the B.S.A. organization, Pack Committee Member's jobs and responsibilities, committee relationship, the service of the Committee, Den Leadership, the pack yearly planning, Cub Scout program and policies as well as some practical problem solving methods.

New committee members as well as veterans will find these sessions helpful as well as educational with both policy and procedural updates and ideas.

The climax of the day will be a session of practical problem solving. After gaining the tools necessary to handle problems, small group sessions, hosted by your presenters, will help tackle proposed complex problems as well as everyday minor situations that you could experience in your committee meetings.

CUBMASTER SESSION

This workshop includes ideas for pack meeting planning, yearly planning, ceremonies, pack games, skits, group songs and audience participations.

You will also brainstorm effective Join Scouting Night planning, boy and leader recruitment, boy and leader recognitions, cub behavior, and differences in coordinating large packs vs. small packs.

Work on Webelos transition ideas, Webelos camp planning and troop coordination.

There will be discussions about the Internet and its' resources as well as your parent resources and talents.

Some separate sessions will be tailored for novice or experienced Cubmasters. There will be question and answer periods, idea sharing time and "good old networking."

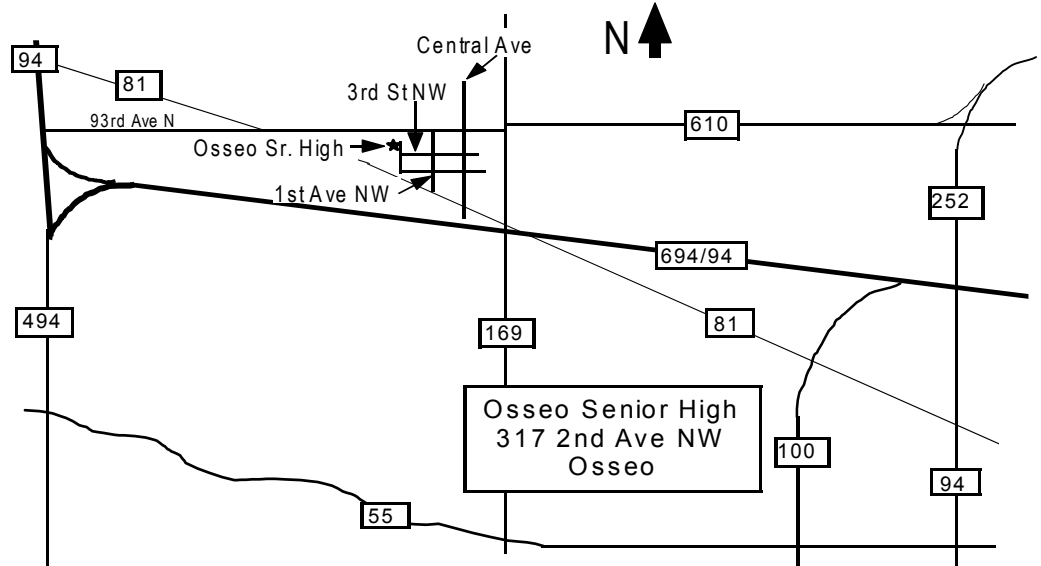
