Cub Scout Day Camp: Cub Scout Day camp is a program for Cub Scouts (2nd & 3rd graders). It requires a staff that meets daily at various Minneapolis and suburban parks or at our camp north of Anoka. The Scouts come each day to the program from the surrounding community. The season lasts from late June to early August.

Cub Scout Resident Camp: Our resident camp for Webelos Cub Scouts is held at Stearns Scout Camp just north of Annandale. This camp for boys (in the 4th & 5th grade) requires a staff that lives at camp from late June to early August. Meals and lodging are included. One 24 hour period off per week.

Boy Scout Camp: Many Point Scout Camp for Boy Scouts in the 6th thru 12th grade is located northeast of Detroit Lakes. The staff lives at camp from mid-June to mid-August. Meals and lodging included. One 24 hour period off per week.

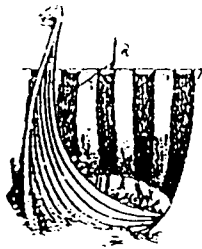
