Yes, believe it or not, it's time to start planning for Webelos Camp 2003! Because Webelos Camp is so popular and continues to grow each year, there is no simple way to take reservations. We have come up with a plan that we feel will be fair to all and will give your Webelos a wonderful camping experience.

- THIS IS NOT A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED REGISTRATION PROCESS... On November 8th we will take all reservations received up to that point and draw lottery-style to place packs in one of their choices of sessions. You will be notified in December regarding which session you were placed in.
- Please use the enclosed form(s) to register your group for Webelos Camp. *This form can be turned in any time from the day you receive it until 5:00 PM on November 8th.* Your \$50.00 site deposit from the pack will hold your session for you. (This \$50.00 deposit will be deducted from your final payment due **May 1, 2003**.)
- Please try to estimate the number of boys attending camp as closely as you can. **Space is limited**, so please check your numbers carefully. **KEEP THE RATIO OF 1 ADULT FOR EVERY 5 BOYS**. If more adults would like to attend camp, have them split the session between them. If there is a medical reason, please send the name(s) and reason(s) along with your registration. HOWEVER, YOU SHOULD HAVE 1 ADULT THAT STAYS IN CAMP THE FULL SESSION FOR CONTINUITY.
- The fee for 4th grade camp is \$75.00 per person for both boys and adults, and for 5th grade camp the fee is \$90.00 per person for both boys and adults. A \$30.00 per person deposit is due by 5:00 p.m. on January 24, 2003. Forms to submit this deposit will be sent to you with your medical forms and session confirmation in December. THIS \$30.00 PER PERSON DEPOSIT IS NOT REFUNDABLE NOR CAN IT BE APPLIED AGAINST ANOTHER CAMPER'S FINAL BALANCE. ANYONE MAKING A \$30.00 DEPOSIT IN JANUARY WILL LOSE THE DEPOSIT, UNLESS SOMEONE ELSE GOES TO CAMP IN HIS OR HER PLACE. Our Webelos Camping Committee feels that parents need to make this commitment very early in order for us to estimate each session's attendance as closely as possible making sure that each boy who wants a Webelos camping experience will get one. The final payment for camp along with medical forms will then be due in the Scout Office by May 1, 2003.
